FORMAT & SCHEDULE

SATURDAY 28 FEB 2026

ALL TIMES ARE IN LOCAL NSW DST

- Lanes oiled
- **Stage 1:** Bowl 10 games
- Squad A check in by 8:30 am for a 9:00AM
- B Squad check in by 2:00pm for a 2:30PM start
- Top 10 male and Top 6 female qualifiers will advance to the second stage.
- The Top 3 bowlers (mixed gender) who miss the cut, will qualify for the Graded Stepladder Final that will run at the same time as the Open Stepladder Final on Sunday.
- Graded will use 100% of 220 handicap system

SUNDAY 1 MARCH 2026

- Top 10 male bowlers and the Top 6 female bowlers check-in by 8:00AM for 8:30AM start of Stage 2. Lanes oiled.
- **Stage 2:** Top 10 males and Top 6 females from stage 1 will bowl an additional four games with pinfall carrying from stage 1.
- At the conclusion of Stage 2, the field cuts to the third stage, the Top 3 Stepladder Final. This final will comprise of the top 3 females and top 3 males.
- Ties for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd decided by a 1 game playoff if required. All other ties decided by highest pinfall from qualifying.
- **Stage 3:** The Top 3 Males and Top 3 Females from Stage 2, and Top 3 Graded Stepladder finalists (Top 3 bowlers who missed the Stage 2 cut) will participate in stage 3.
- The Male and Female bowler who win the Stepladder Finals will be crowned 2026 TBA Inclusion Cup champions, whilst, the winner of the Graded Final will be crowned 2026 TBA Inclusion Cup Graded Final Champion.
- Ties to be decided by a 1 game playoff if required.

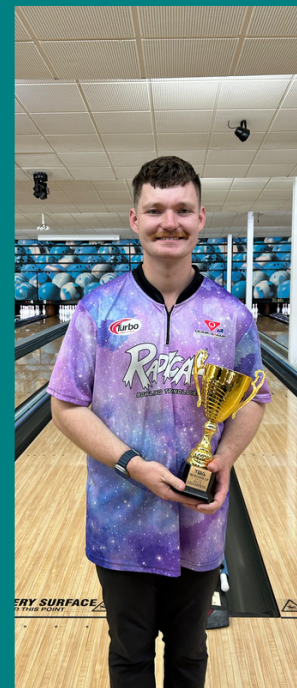
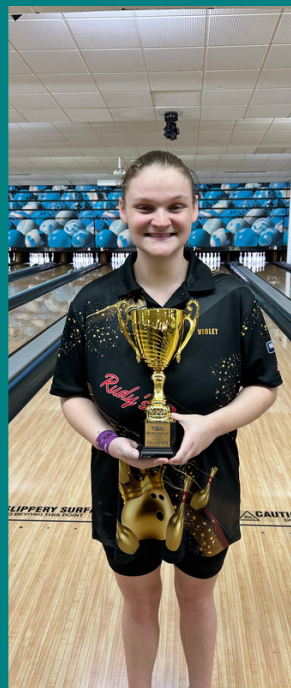

Rules & Regulations

- This is a scratch event that is open to all 2026 TBA registered bowlers who have a disability. TBA defines a bowler with a disability “A bowler with a disability is defined as any condition of the body or mind (impairment) that makes it more difficult for the person with the condition to do certain activities (activity limitation) and interact with the world around them (participation restrictions). The condition is permanent. It should be noted that degree or degrees of pain are not considered a disability.
- If requested, to prove a disability, a bowler needs to provide one the types of evidence listed in RULE 214 - Disability Definition of, in the TBA League, Tournament & General Playing Rules of, in the TBA League, Tournament & General Playing Rules
- Any bowler who is unsure of their eligibility to compete should apply to the Tournament Director for final ruling. Bowlers may be asked to provide written medical information. It is the bowler’s responsibility to ensure evidence in support of their disability can be produced. Failure to produce acceptable evidence may result in disqualification with further participation in the tournament not permitted.
- All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA rules and regulations.
- TBA Inclusion ranking points will be allocated to all TBA registered bowlers
- TBA will complete registration checks prior to the commencement of the event
- Entry Fee: \$250 via the TenpinResults portal – a \$90 deposit is required at the time of entry nomination, with the balance to be paid by 23 February 2026.
- Refund of Entry Fees – Should a refund of a player’s entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount will be transferred to the player’s portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:
 - 1) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries on TenpinResults
 - 2) Request a Cash-Out of the total credit amount less the processing fee (3%)
- Dress code – appropriate bowling attire to be worn – dress shorts for men will be permitted. Jeans, tights, or track pants are not acceptable.
- The Tournament Director and TBA reserve the right to check any bowler’s equipment at any time. Any equipment to be found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.
- Any bowler that fails to check in on Sunday 1 March 2026 will be replaced by the first available reserve.
- Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.
- Smoking, Consumption of alcohol and use of mobile phones while competing are not permitted.
- Ties for 1st, 2nd & 3rd at the end of Stage 2 will be decided by a 1-game playoff. Stage 3 ties are determined by a 1 game roll.
- Ties for 10th place (males) and 6th place (females) to qualify for Stage 2 will be decided by a 1-game playoff. If tie remains, a 9th and 10th Frame playoff will be activated. If a tie still remains, a sudden death roll-off will occur until the tie is broken.
- Eligibility for the ‘High Game Out-of-Cut’ bonus prize will be awarded to the participant who does not make the cut for the second stage, and has the highest game bowled in qualifying.
